Service 1: Jan.-Mar. Early Spring Visit

This liquid application will control weeds presently in the turf. Also a pre-emergent will to be applied to help prevent weeds from germinating in the spring. Post-emergent weed control results will vary this time of year as weather will play a big role in the effectiveness early on.

Service 2: Feb.-April Spring Visit

All lawns will receive a second application of broadleaf weed control, grassy weed control, and crabgrass pre-emergent. In addition, all lawns will receive an iron application to help the turf green as it transitions out of dormancy. **Full program customers will receive an insect control application on this service.

Service 3: April-May Early Summer Visit

All lawns will receive a balanced extended release fertilizer that will provide the turf with the nutrients needed for greening and growth. Broadleaf weeds will be treated if needed.

Service 4: May-July Summer Visit

All lawns will receive a balanced extended release fertilizer that will provide the turf with the nutrients needed for greening and growth. Broadleaf weeds will be treated if needed. St. Augustine lawns will be inspected for chinch bugs and notification will be given if present.

Service 5: July-Sept. Early Fall Visit

All lawns will receive an Iron application for continued greening and monitored for any insect activity. All broadleaf weeds will be treated (temperature permitting).

Service 6: Sept.-Nov. Fall Visit

This application may be granular or liquid depending on the needs of the turf and climate at the time of this service. Bermuda lawns will receive a nitrogen fertilizer which will store through winter for early greening for the next growing season. This application also contains a pre-emergent to prevent winter weeds from germinating. **Full program customers will receive an insect control application on this service.

Service 7: Oct.-Nov. Winter Visit

This application will reinforce the pre-emergent barrier that was created on the previous application to insure that winter weeds do not germinate during the dormant season. Lime or Sulfur applications can be done at this time to correct soil PH.

Full Program customers WILL NOT be charged extra for grassy weed control or disease control. If you would like GRASSY WEED, DISEASE, or INSECT CONTROL we recommend our Full Program.

** The full program has two double applications a year for insect control and the scheduled service.
